



Faith Formation Fall Plans!

During these unprecedented times, we are asking for love, grace, and mercy as we navigate how to safely reopen our Sunday School and Confirmation programs. Below is what has been determined by the Board of Christian Education.

Sunday School - Begins 10/4/20; 9:00am - 9:45am

Drop Off Procedures: All children will enter SOUTH DOORS (Playground). Upon arrival, students will have temperatures taken and will wash their hands in the nearest bathrooms. Masks will need to be worn for all children (except Preschool) and adults. A roster will be kept of all children and adults in attendance.

Pick Up Procedures: One adult (or older sibling) may come and pick up child; mask must be worn by this individual. Children may exit SOUTH (playground) or NORTH (gym) doors.

Things to Know: Children are recommended to bring own water bottles as drinking fountains are unavailable. Teachers will be disinfecting rooms after students leave. Some classes may be combined due to smaller numbers

PLEASE: Be prompt on drop-off and pick-up of your child due to the additional measures that must now be taken in order to meet in person.

If Ottawa County raises to a RED or PURPLE county, Sunday School will be suspended until it is deemed safe to meet in person again.

Confirmation - Begins 10/4/20

Things to Know: 7th and 8th grade classes will be separated this year to better focus on faith formation. 7th grade will focus on foundational principles. 8th grade will focus on the personal relationship with Christ. UCC Affirming Faith Curriculum will be used. Above guidelines will be followed!
