THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THE FULL ARMOR OF GOD



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

This is the final week in our series about the full Armor of God. Today we reviewed each piece of the armor and encouraged students to put on the full armor of God. Ephesians 6:10-18, The Full Armor of God



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kids if they can relate each piece of the Armor of God to some safety equipment they use in sports or other activities - like the pads worn by football players. Ask them why it's important to always wear their armor.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- What are the different parts of the Armor of God?
- Why is it important to wear the Armor of God daily?
- Why is it important to pray constantly?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"So put on all of God's armor. Evil days will come. But you will be able to stand up to anything. And after you have done everything you can, you will still be standing."
Ephesians 6:13 (NirV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

Just like a football player would never take the field without all of his pads, we need to dress in the full Armor of God every day. Pray that you and your children will make prayer a daily habit and that God will arm you for the spiritual battles you all face each day.
